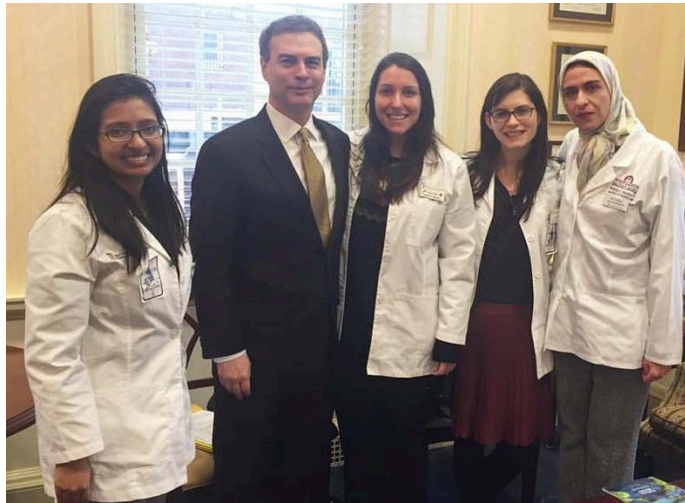

Project Goal Outcomes

- **Collaboration** among student organizations resulted in approximately 2717 patients receiving diverse pharmacy health services
- 21 **student-led** patient care events delivered throughout greater Maryland community
- Approximately 303 student pharmacists **educated** through advocacy training

UMSOP Future Advocacy Goals

- Increase interprofessional **collaboration** among community outreach efforts
- Professionally developed patient testimonial brochures and videos—currently undergoing editing—sent to state legislators
- State-wide letter campaign urging support of H.R. 594/S. 109 to national legislators
